ITU-D has two study groups. Study group 1 objective is in enabling the environment for the development of telecommunications/ICT and Study Group 2 is on ICT services and applications for the promotion of sustainable development.

As mentioned above ITU-D mandate is on development of telecommunications/ICT activities and implementing projects,
