THe PRF-21 will address issues related to the COVID-19 pandemic in relation to Pillars of the Strategic Plan if the APT for 2021-2023. PRF-21 will consist of a special Ministerial Session from APT member Administrations to share insights, experiences, lessons learned, policies being implemented in their countries with regard to the fight against the COVID-19 pandemic and digital transformation, which is an objective of the Singapore Statement adopted by the ICT Ministers of APT.

The Forum will also include a special roundtable session among Head of Regulators to share their experiences as well as engage in dialogue to identify the challenging issues and how to enhance cooperation between regulators/policymakers to smoothen the deployment of 5Gin the Asia Pacific region.
